REQUIREMENTS FOR TESTING IN YOUR VEHICLE:

- Not all instructors test in personal vehicles. Please check with the office to make sure the appointment you've scheduled is with an instructor that will do so.
- Valid insurance and registration. These must be CURRENT (check your expiration date) and either ORIGINAL, PRINTED copies OR on the MyColorado (or your insurance carrier's) app. PICTURES OF THE DOCUMENTS ON YOUR PHONE ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- Signal, brake, and headlights in working order
- License plates mounted on both FRONT AND BACK of the outside of the vehicle (temporary tags are the exception to this). The stickers need to be current.
- Working door latches (can be opened from both the inside and outside)
- Functioning front windows
- No cracks in windshield across the field of vision of either the student or the tester.
- No dash warning lights (check engine/oil pressure/ABS/air bags, etc.)
- Please ensure vehicle is clean.

Customer vehicles must meet ALL the requirements listed and be in overall safe working condition. Testers have the right to refuse the test if the vehicle seems unsafe in any way.
